Northern Peru boasts some of the finest archaeological sites on the planet. Cultures such as the Moche and the Chimu left impressive monuments in the centuries before the Incas.

Departing from Lima we head north into the natural wonderland of Huaraz. From here we move to the northern coastal city of Trujillo, where we can admire the colourful colonial houses in the main Plaza.

We visit the mud adobe fortress of Chan Chan and pyramid structures of Sipan.

Moving onwards from Trujillo we make our way back the Andes and perhaps northern Peru's greatest wonder, the Kuelap fortress and Chachapoyas. We return back to Lima, stopping in at picturesque villages off the beaten track.
